

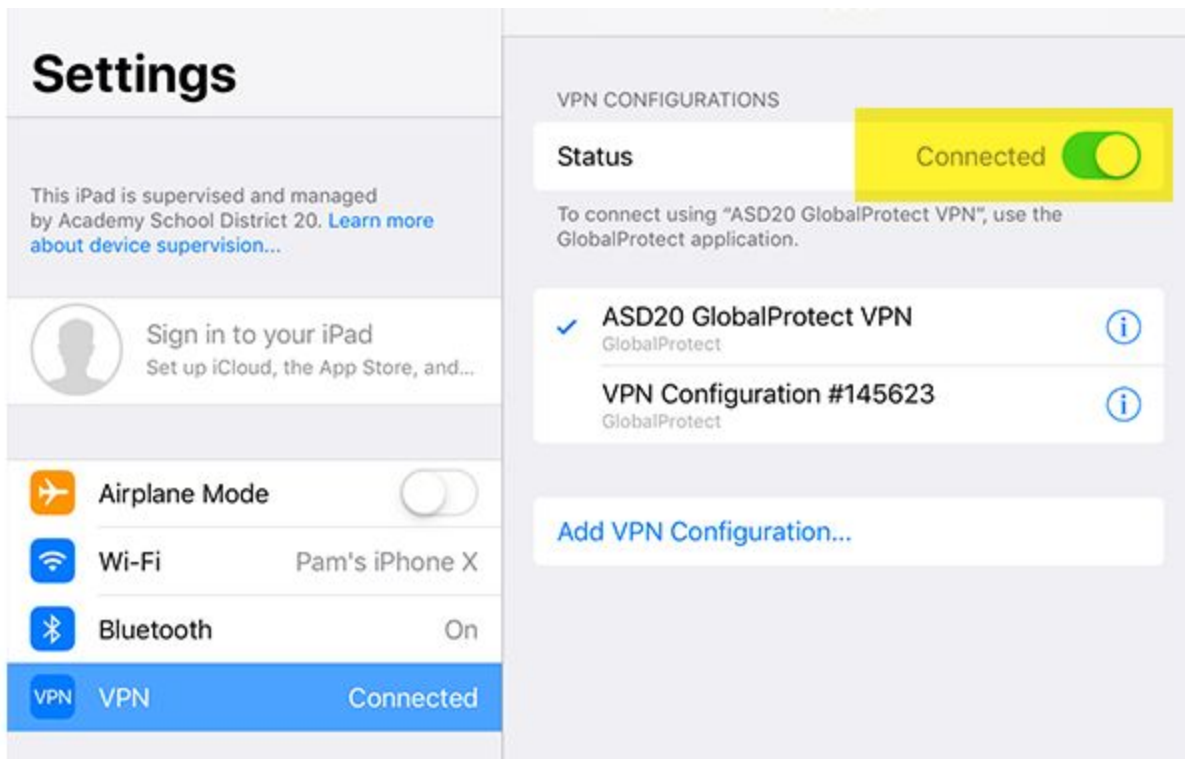
## District 20 VPN Instructions

Unless you have specifically opted out from utilizing District 20 web filtering all elementary and middle school students **MUST connect through the GlobalProtect VPN app in order to be able to access the Internet from the iPad at home.**

**\*There is a one time initial setup and sign in you must complete (Steps are listed underneath Initial Setup below)** Once you have done these steps it will remember your credentials and you can turn on and off the VPN from the slider bar in the settings menu as shown below with a single tap.

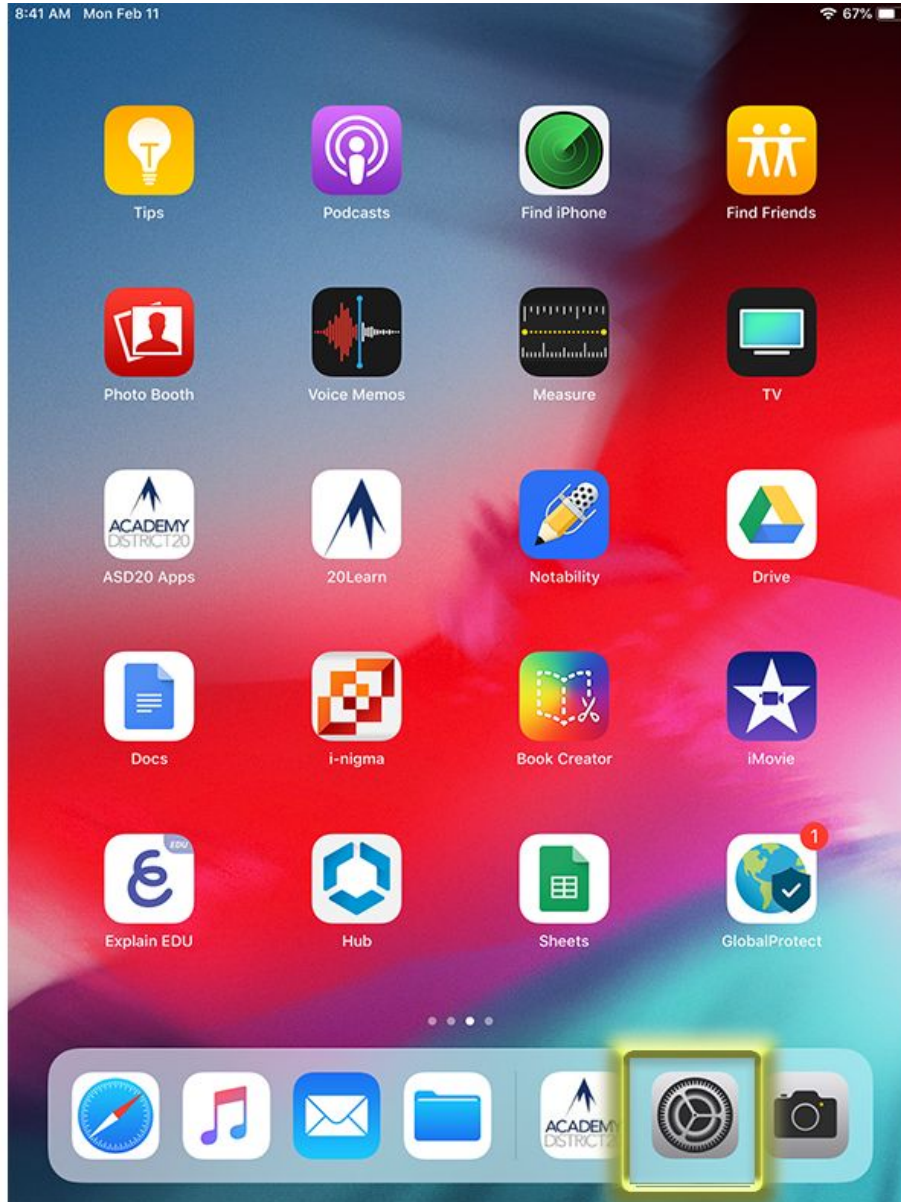
**\*In order to use the iPad at home the slider must be green and say connected.**

**\*While at school the slider bar must be turned off and be white/grey. Otherwise you will encounter network issues.**

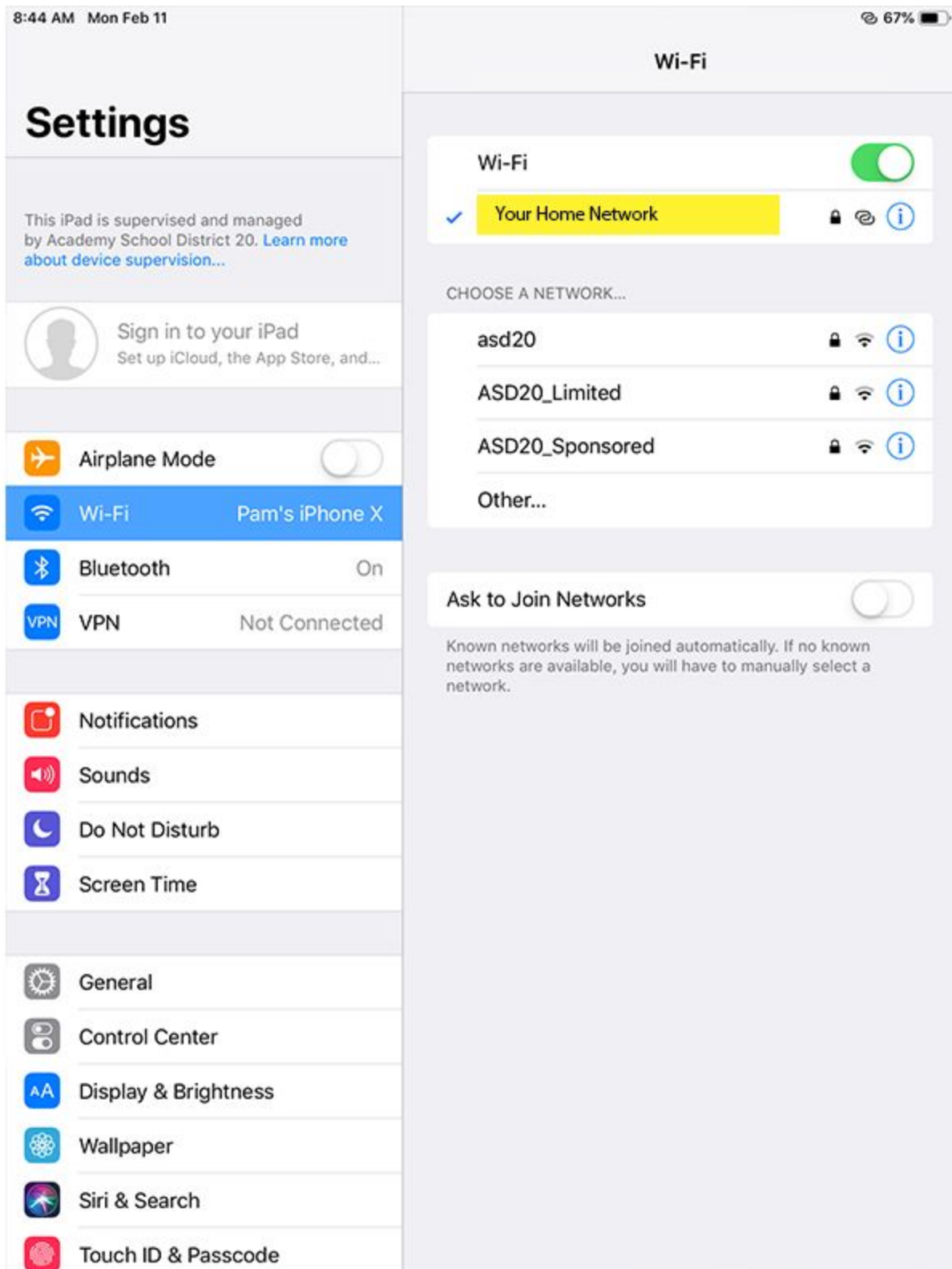


# Initial Setup

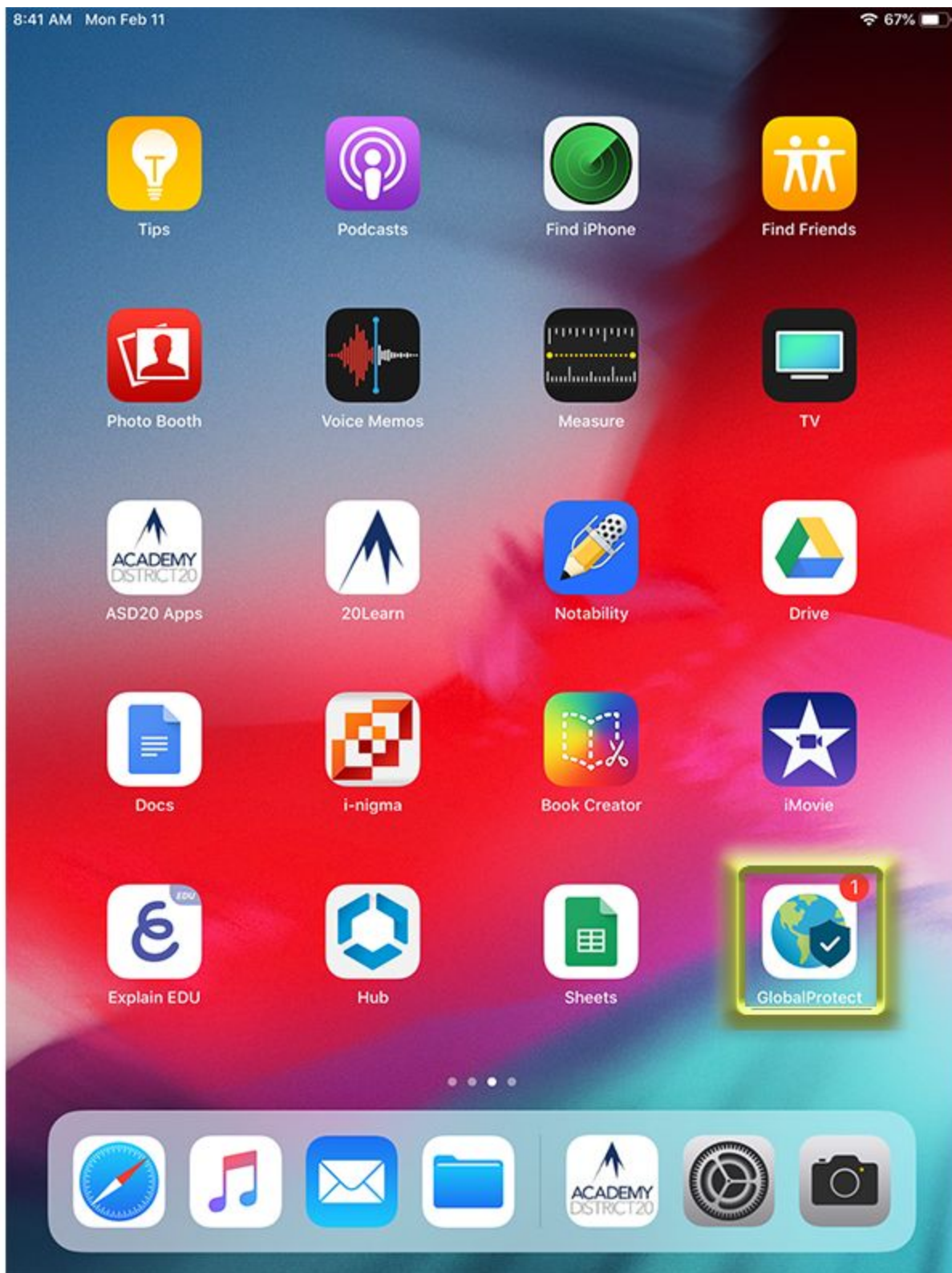
Tap on Settings



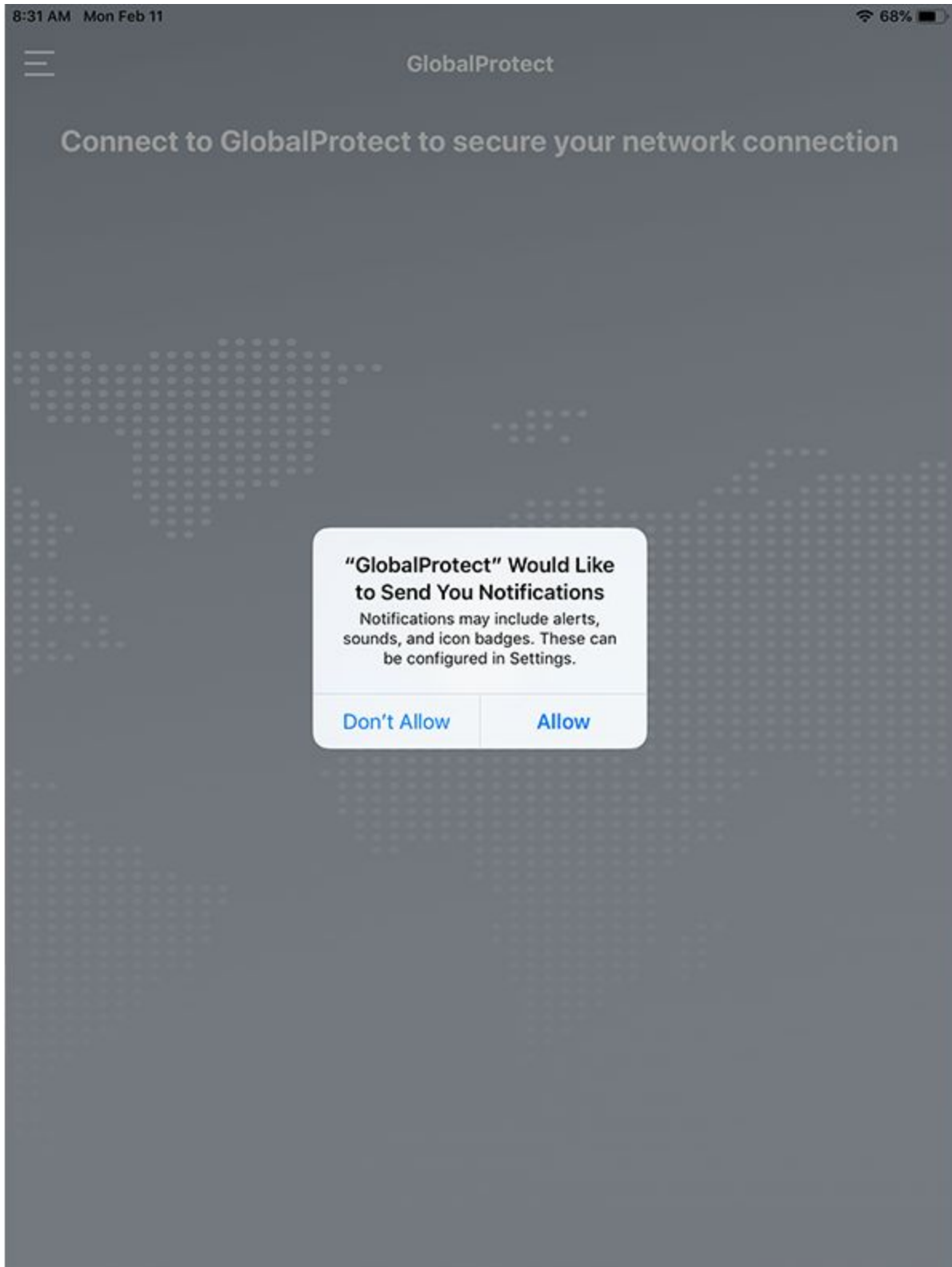
Connect to your Home WiFi and make sure there is a blue checkmark next to it.



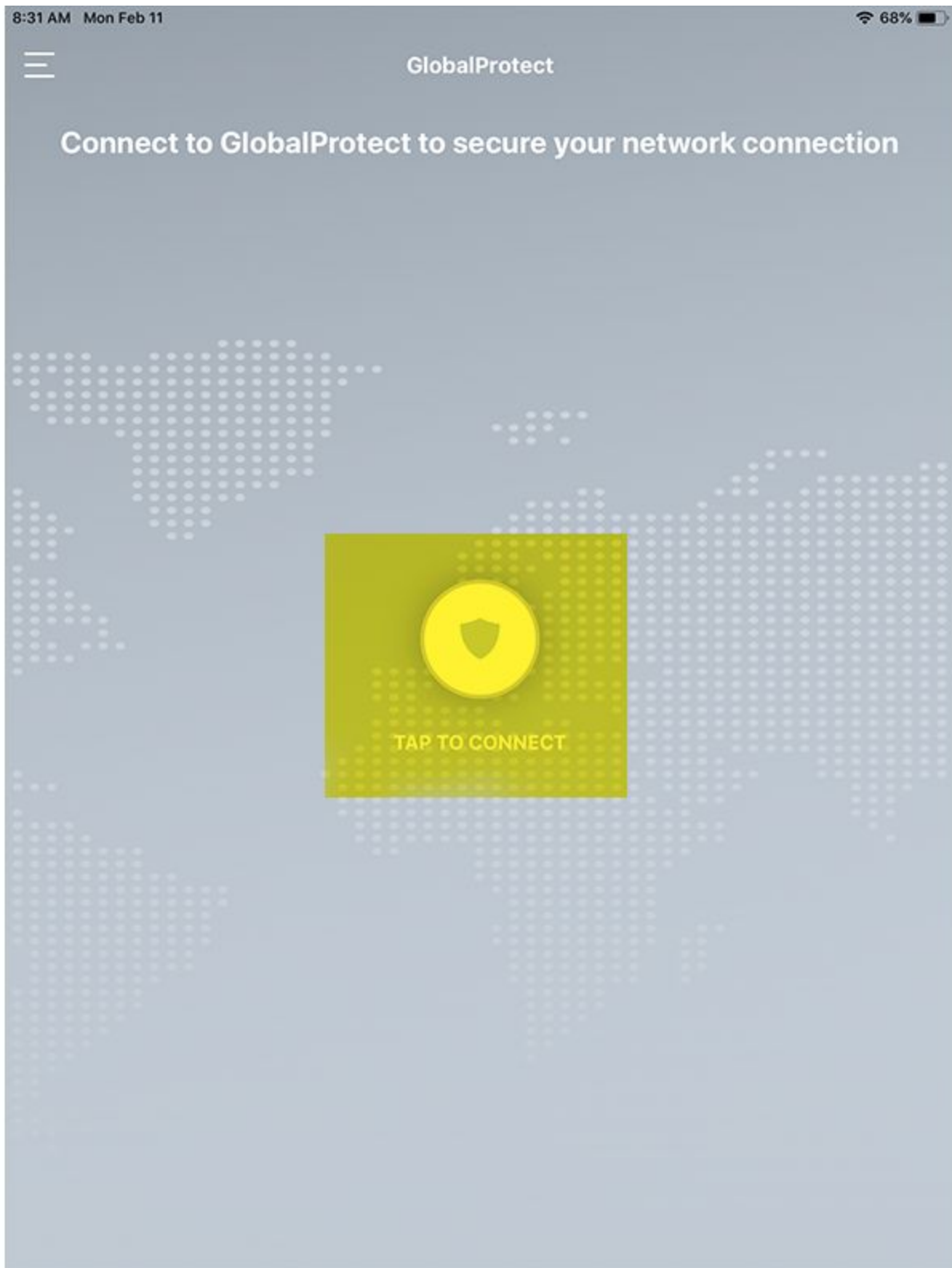
## Open The GlobalProtect VPN App

## Tap to connect and Sign into the VPN

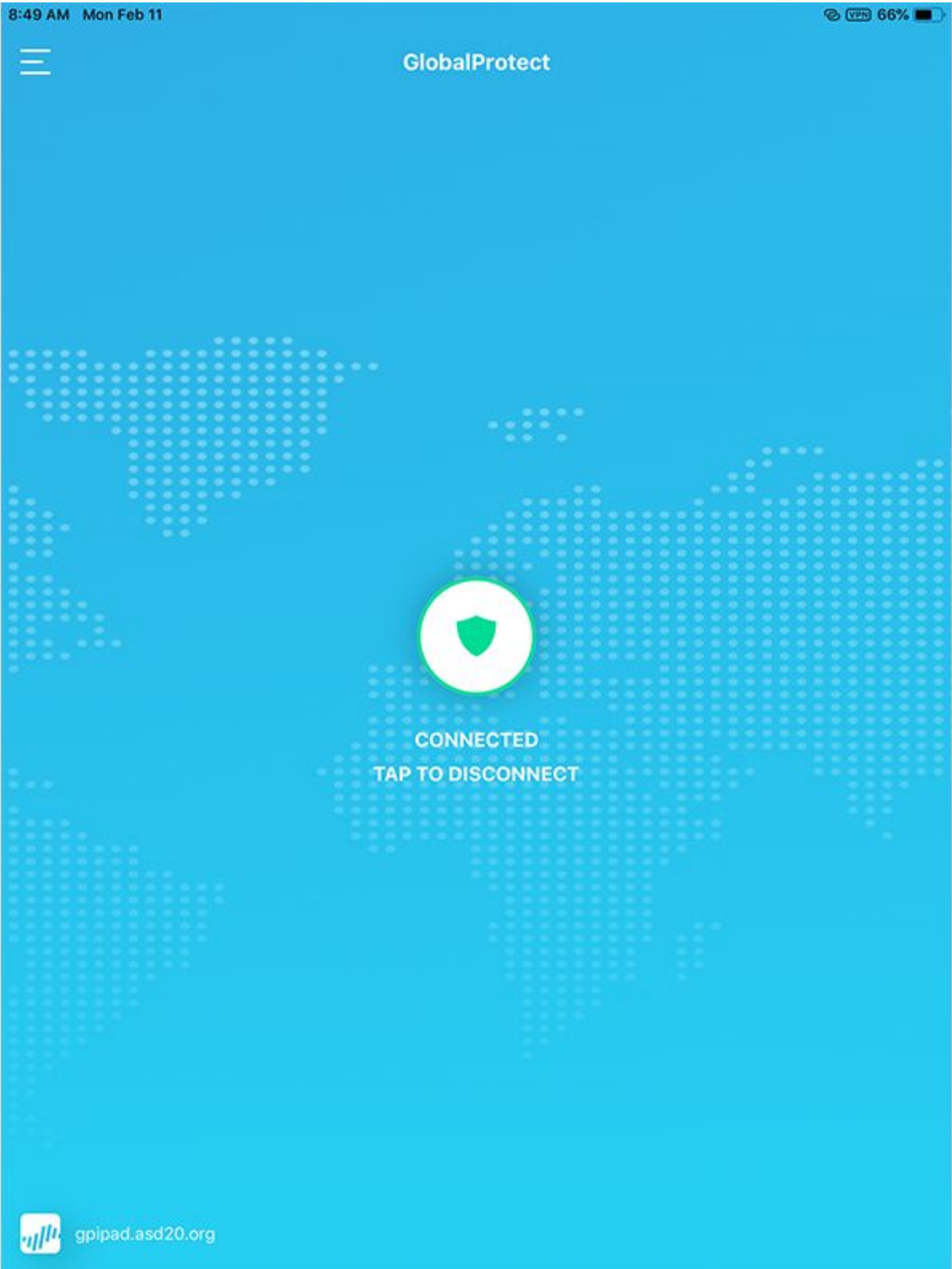


The next page should have **gpipad.asd20** auto filled out for portal. (If it is not you may need to reinstall the app, or send your student into the tech office so they can have it fixed.)

Next put in your **6 digit student ID#** for your username followed by your students district password. (If you don't know your password it can be reset [here](#) by selecting (Student Password Change Self-Service))
